'Global Christianity' find out about how Christians pray & worship in many different cultures & traditions across the world. Crosses, Holy Communion, Prayer, Icons, artefacts.

'A Journey Round the World's Faiths' Explore, question, open the mystery bags. Step into the shoes of believers – Judaism, Buddhism, Hinduism, Islam, Sikhism, Christianity.

'Unpack Christmas & Easter' bring these festivals alive as children meet characters from the Bible & explore the stories (may also include global/multicultural celebrations).
