


Planning your Advent & Christmas work?

I enjoyed delivering Life in WW2 last year in Norfolk and in Nottinghamshire. This programme worked well in both KS1 & 2. I had not done it for year 1 before but with some alterations to content it worked really well. It is fast paced and interactive so that the children get involved with what it would have been like to be growing up during the war. We dance and sing too!

Delivering 'Faiths round the World' days in different ways worked well last year. In a village CE school setting it was explored across the whole school with Collective Worship to start and a finale reflection time together.

I also homed in on it in a different way for a large year 5 group.





A school asked for a bespoke session about Suffragettes and this was fun to bring alive. There are interesting local stories about women who showed great commitment to the cause in Norfolk.

I am excited about working with a school again on my **Prehistoric Adventure** soon. I have some large fossil digging sand trays and lots of factual stories. Many like to focus on Mary Anning and this can also be drawn into the session. Pangea is also covered if appropriate.
